

OWNERSHIP AND USE OF THE CLUB FACILITIES

E A Operations LLC, doing business as Green Valley Country Club, (the “Company”) owns the clubhouse and recreational facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club (the “Club”). Use of the facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club will be available to Members of the Club, guests of Members, outing golfers, special event attendees and other persons permitted by the Club from time to time.

The Member of the Club acknowledges that Membership in the Club is non-participatory and does not include (i) any ownership, proprietary interest prescriptive easement in any of the assets of the Club; (ii) any right to receive or participate in the earnings of the Club; or (iii) any voting rights or any right to participate in the management of the Club.

The Member acknowledges and agrees that Membership in the Club grants only a revocable license in favor of the Member, the Member’s Family, and the Member’s guests, to use the Facilities, in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Membership Agreement, and the Rules and Regulations, as same may be amended from time to time in the Company’s sole discretion.

MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

The Club will initially make available eight classifications of membership known as “Golf Memberships”, “Senior Golf Memberships”, “Junior Golf Memberships”, “Sports Memberships”, “Corporate Golf Memberships”, “Dining Memberships” and “Non-Resident Memberships”. Members of the Club are allowed to use the facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club in accordance with this Membership Plan. By obtaining a membership at Green Valley Country Club, Members obtain a non-exclusive revocable license to use the facilities in accordance with the classification of membership selected by the Member. Members do not obtain any equity or ownership interest in the Club or the facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club, do not have and do not acquire any property rights or other interest in any property of the Club, do not have any rights to become involved in the management or operation of the Club or the facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club and are not subject to any assessments for operating deficits incurred in the operation of the facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club or any assessments for capital improvements to the Club Facilities.

INDEMNIFICATION AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

By executing the Application and Membership Agreement, the Member hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold Green Valley Country Club (and their respective owners, directors, partners, officers, operators, employees and other agents) harmless from and against any and all liabilities, costs (including reasonable attorney’s fees), claims, demands or damages incident to or arising out of or relating to the acts or omissions of the member, their Family or guest(s), and their respective use or occupancy of the Facilities. In addition, by executing this Agreement, the Member hereby voluntarily assumes all risks of accident or damage to the Member’s person or property, and the person or property of the Member’s Family and guests, arising out of or relating to the use or occupancy of the Facilities including but not limited to errant golf balls, operation of a golf cart, adverse weather conditions including lightening.

MEMBERSHIP PLAN

A. INTRODUCTION MEMBERSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Green Valley Country Club is offering an opportunity to be a Member of a private, non-equity golf club. Pursuant to this Membership Plan, the privilege of using the facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club is available to Members of the Club, guests of Members, outing golfers, special event attendees and other persons permitted by the Club from time to time.

B. CLUB FACILITIES

DESCRIPTION OF THE CLUB FACILITIES

The facilities to be provided at Green Valley Country Club which are referred to herein as the “Club Facilities,” include the following:

- One eighteen-hole golf course
- Golf practice facilities including a practice range and putting green
- Golf shop
- Dining facilities and lounge
- Seasonal swimming pool (some restrictions may apply)
- Three clay and two hard tennis courts
- Locker facilities
- Fitness facilities

C. MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

EIGHT CLASSIFICATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES ARE INITIALLY AVAILABLE AT GREEN VALLEY COUNTRY CLUB

The Club will initially make available eight classifications of non-equity membership known as “Golf Memberships”, “Junior Golf Memberships”, “Senior Golf Memberships”, “Sports Memberships”, “Corporate Golf Memberships”, “Dining Memberships”, and “Non-Resident Memberships”. The Club may issue other classifications of membership in the future.

A “Golf Member” is defined as someone the age of 35 through 71 who purchases a Membership with full golf and social privileges. Golf Memberships are available for families.

A “Junior Golf Member” is defined as someone the age of 21 through 34 who purchases a Membership with full golf and social privileges. Junior Golf Memberships are available for families.

A “Corporate Golf Member” is defined as someone who purchases a Membership with full golf and social privileges in the name of an ongoing operating business and up to four designees may be Members under the same “Corporate Golf Membership” if available for the families of the designees if and only if they are owners, partners, directors, officers and/or employees of the Company. Corporate Golf Memberships are available for families of the designees.

A “Sports Member” is defined as someone who purchases a Membership with tennis, pool, fitness and social privileges. Sports Memberships are available for families.

A “Dining Member” is defined as someone who purchases a Membership with only dining privileges. Dining Memberships are available for families.

A “Non-Resident Member” is defined as someone who purchases a Membership with limited golf and social privileges and primarily lives outside a 40 mile radius of the Club. Non-Resident Memberships are available for families.

ADDITIONAL CLASSIFICATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP MAY BE MADE AVAILABLE BY THE CLUB

The Club may issue other classifications of membership. If additional classifications of membership are made available, the Club will establish the use privileges of the additional membership classifications, the number of memberships available and the membership initiation fee, monthly dues, fees and other charges to be paid for these additional classifications of membership. The Club may also discontinue offering any classification of membership at any time.

USE OF THE MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES BY THE MEMBER AND THE MEMBER’S IMMEDIATE FAMILY
All Memberships at Green Valley Country Club are family memberships for the use of the Member and his/her immediate family.

The term “immediate family members” shall include the legal spouse (i.e., spouse legally married as recognized by the State of South Carolina) of the member and the unmarried children of such member and his/her spouse, who are under the age of twenty-three and either living in the member’s residence or attending school on a full-time basis. The Club reserves the right to restrict access to the golf facilities by children who are immediate family members during primary playing times.



MEMBERS OF THE CLUB ARE NOT SUBJECT TO OPERATING ASSESSMENTS OR CAPITAL ASSESSMENTS
Club Members are not subject to any assessments for operating deficits incurred in the operation of the Club Facilities or for assessments in connection with capital improvements to the Club Facilities. The Club shall fund any operating deficits incurred in the operation of the Club Facilities and shall retain all operating surplus resulting from operation of the Club Facilities.

The payment of dues, use fees, charges, dining and/or usage minimums, state taxes, service charges and other personal charges that the Club may establish from time to time is required to obtain and maintain membership privileges at Green Valley Country Club and is not considered an operating assessment or capital assessment.

MAXIMUM NUMBER OF MEMBERSHIPS AVAILABLE AT GREEN VALLEY COUNTRY CLUB

The Club reserves the right to limit the number of Memberships based on the capacity of the golf facilities and the extent of use and patterns of use of the golf facilities by Members.

CLUB MEMBERS OBTAIN SPECIFIC MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

The privileges of a Club Membership are subject to this Membership Plan, as amended from time to time. Upon approval by the Club, payment of the applicable membership initiation fee, dues, fees, and charges and compliance with the Rules and Regulations established by the Club, Club Members obtain the following use privileges.

MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES BY CLASSIFICATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Golf Members, Senior Golf Members and Junior Golf Members of Green Valley Country Club will enjoy the following exclusive Membership privileges.

- Unlimited golf with no green fees
- Seven-day advance tee time reservations
- Use of practice facilities and putting green with range balls and driving range available.
- CGA handicap services
- Golf walking privileges anytime
- Club storage available
- Use of hard and clay tennis courts
- Member social and competitive golf and tennis events throughout the year
- Use of fitness facilities
- Use of seasonal outdoor pool
- Use of men's and ladies' locker facilities with locker rental available
- Social events and family activities throughout the year
- Use of private meeting rooms and banquet facilities
- Exempt from banquet room and audio/visual equipment rental charges
- Dining privileges
- Member charging privileges
- No Member assessments

Corporate Golf Members of Green Valley Country Club will enjoy the above Golf Membership privileges in addition having unaccompanied guests enjoy use of the Club.

Sports Members of Green Valley Country Club will enjoy the following exclusive Membership privileges.

- Use of hard and clay tennis courts
- Member social and competitive tennis events throughout the year
- Use of fitness facilities
- Use of seasonal outdoor pool
- Permitted to four rounds of golf per year (based on tee times/not individual family members)
- Use of men's and ladies' locker facilities with locker rental available
- Social events and family activities throughout the year
- Use of private meeting rooms and banquet facilities
- Exempt from banquet room and audio/visual equipment rental charges
- Dining privileges
- Member charging privileges
- No Member assessments

Dining Members of Green Valley Country Club will enjoy the following exclusive Membership privileges.

- Use of men's and ladies' locker facilities
- Permitted to four rounds of golf per year at the current greens fee rate. (based on tee times/not individual family members)
- Social events and family activities throughout the year
- Use of private meeting rooms and banquet facilities
- Exempt from banquet room and audio/visual equipment rental charges
- Dining privileges
- Member charging privileges
- No Member assessment

Non-Resident Members of Green Valley Country Club will enjoy the following exclusive Membership privileges.

- Non-Resident Members primarily reside outside a 40 mile radius of the Club
- Non-Resident Members enjoy the same privileges as Golf Members with the following exceptions:
 - Non-Resident Member may make five-day advance tee time reservations
 - Non-Resident Member are expected to use the facility with limited frequency and are not anticipated to golf more than two times per month in-season (April-October)

CHANGE IN MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATION

The member will pay the difference between the membership initiation fee they paid for their current membership and the initiation fee for the desired membership. Members are permitted to downgrade membership classification one time within a five year period after their one year anniversary date of joining. Membership upgrades will be accepted at any time.

JUNIOR GOLF MEMBERSHIP TRANSITION

Junior Golf Member must transition from their classification of Membership at the time the Junior Member (the older of the two spouses) turns 35. The Junior Golf Member has the option to terminate the Membership or transition to an available Membership category. Should the Member choose to transition to another Membership, the Member would begin paying the dues for the Memberships.

CHANGE OF CORPORATE DESIGNEE

A Corporate Golf Member may change one or more of the designated users one time per year per designee upon approval of the new designee by the Club and payment of the "change in designee fee". The Club reserves the right to establish additional rules regarding Corporate Memberships and adjust the Corporate Membership Program and "change in designee fee" from time to time.

GUEST PRIVILEGES

Club Members may have guests use the Facilities in accordance with the Rules and Regulations established by the Club. The number of times a particular guest may use the facilities or any particular facility provided at Green Valley Country Club during any particular period of time and the number of guests a Member may sponsor at any particular time may be limited. Guest(s) of members are not expected to golf more than two times per quarter. The Club may charge higher guest fees for unaccompanied guests. Sponsoring Members and sponsoring designees may be responsible for the payment of all fees and charges unpaid by their guests.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

A leave of absence may be granted to a member for medical purposes or because of moving out of the area for a minimum of six months and a maximum of two years. A leave of absence can only be used once over a three year period. Members are required to pay 50% of the applicable dues while on the leave of absence. The monthly dining minimum will be waived during the leave of absence period. Member may request a leave of absence by giving a thirty-day advance written notice to the Club. Approval is granted only if the member is current on all payments to the Club. A medical leave shall require written verification from the designated medical doctor overseeing treatment. Only dining facilities may be utilized during a leave of absence. Member may not downgrade their membership category at the time of the Leave of Absence.

D. ELIGIBILITY FOR CLUB MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

ELIGIBILITY FOR CLUB MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

Each prospective Member must submit a Membership Application and Membership Agreement, be approved for membership and pay the required membership dues and fees to the Club prior to obtaining a membership.

E. MEMBERSHIP FEE, DUES, OTHER FEES AND CHARGES

PERSONS DESIRING A CLUB MEMBERSHIP SHALL PAY A FEE TO THE CLUB TO OBTAIN MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

To obtain a Club Membership at Green Valley Country Club, the applicant shall pay an initiation fee to the Club. Initiation fees paid to the Club may be used for any purpose determined appropriate by the Club, in its sole discretion. The amount of the initiation fee and the manner of payment of the initiation fee shall be established by the Club from time to time, and is further described in the Membership Agreement.

GUARANTEE

Members agree to be responsible for all Dues and other charges at any time incurred by the Member, the Member's Family and Guests. By executing the Application and Membership Agreement and payment of the membership Initiation Fee, the Member unconditionally and irrevocably guarantees the full and timely payment of any Dues and charges or other sums which may become payable to the Club by Member, and by the Member's Family and Guests. In the event the Member fails to timely pay any applicable Dues, charges or other sums with respect to the Membership, the Member may become subject to suspension or expulsion from the Club, pursuant to applicable provisions contained herein.

OTHER CLUB FEES ESTABLISHED BY THE CLUB

The Club will establish the Club Fees to be paid by Golf Members from time to time. A quarterly dining minimum will be charged each quarter to all Membership Classifications except Non-Resident Members. The quarterly dining minimum is an obligation to spend the required amount each quarter on dining purchases including all beverages and alcohol at the Club. Taxes and service charges are not included in the dining minimum. If you do not meet the minimum in any given quarter, you are billed for the difference between your actual spending and your obligation. The obligation is per-quarter and not accrued on an annual basis.

Annually, the Club will review the existing club dues, cart fees and other fees and decide on any increases or decreases. The Club will provide 30 days written notice to the members of the Club's intent to increase or decrease or otherwise change the Schedule of Fees, Dues and Charges including the monthly dues.

The Club will establish the amount of dues, fees and other charges to be paid by each Member and designee at Green Valley Country Club from time to time. The amount of dues payable by each Member and designee will depend upon the classification of membership and level of dues selected. In order to properly maintain the Club Facilities and continue to offer Members quality facilities and services, dues will be based on Member demand, market conditions and other pertinences.

The obligation to pay dues is not dependent on the availability of all the facilities or the frequency of use. Repair and maintenance of the facilities and/or other occurrences may make it necessary for the Club to change hours of use or restrict the use of the facilities or to close certain facilities temporarily. The Club will not reduce or suspend dues during the time when the Club Facilities, in whole or in part, are not available.

DUES SHALL BE PAYABLE IN ADVANCE ON A MONTHLY BASIS

Dues will be billed to the member account in advance each month along with dining minimum and other charges from the previous month and will be shown on the monthly billing statement.

DUES, MEMBER ACCOUNT PAYMENTS AND STATEMENTS

The Club will email statements that record all purchases from the prior month and the current month dues by the last business day of the month. Payments required by credit card are processed on the first business day of the month.

The current dues for use of the Club Facilities are set forth on the current Dues & Fees outlined in the Membership documents. Membership dues are pro-rated based on the month joined. The dues, fees and other charges of the Club are subject to change from time to time in the sole discretion of the Club.

SUSPENSION AND TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES FOR NON-PAYMENT OF DUES, FEES AND OTHER CHARGES

The failure of any Club Member to timely pay dues, fees and other charges after 30 days

of the month and the failure to pay all amounts of the membership fee when due, shall constitute grounds for suspension and/or termination of membership privileges at the Club. In the event a membership is terminated, then the Member will no longer have any membership privileges to use the Club Facilities and such terminated member shall be deemed to have resigned. Accounts that are past due at 30 days will incur a \$25 late fee per month until their account becomes current.

F. APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

THE PRIVILEGES OF CLUB MEMBERS TO USE THE CLUB FACILITIES ARE GOVERNED ONLY BY THIS MEMBERSHIP PLAN

If approved for membership at the Club, the Member agrees to be bound by the terms and conditions of this Membership Plan, as it may be amended from time to time and agrees to release and indemnify the Club for any and all damages and injuries resulting from use of the Club Facilities as further set forth in the Rules and Regulations.

G. TRANSFER OF CLUB MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

TRANSFER OF CLUB MEMBERSHIPS

Club Members may not sell, transfer or otherwise assign their membership privileges except to the Club and therefore, Club Members may not transfer or otherwise assign their Club Membership at Green Valley Country Club directly to any third party.

RESIGNATION OF MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

Club Members who desire to resign their membership privileges must give the Club 90 days prior written notice of their intention to resign membership privileges. The resignation of membership privileges will become effective upon receipt of written notice from the Member and payment of the membership fee and all outstanding dues, fees and other charges in full to the Club.

If the membership is terminated by the member before the two year anniversary date of joining, the member is responsible for the balance of all dues payable upon termination through the term of the two year membership commitment.

TRANSFER OF CLUB MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES UPON THE DEATH OF A CLUB MEMBER AT GREEN VALLEY COUNTRY CLUB

Upon the death of a Member at Green Valley Country Club, the membership shall be transferred to the Member's surviving spouse, if any, without the payment of any additional membership fee. If a deceased Member is not survived by a spouse, or the surviving spouse does not desire to continue with the deceased Member's membership, then the membership of the deceased Member shall be deemed to be resigned.

Upon the death of a designee of a Corporate Membership, then the company may designate another designee approved by the Club to use the membership privileges without the payment of any change of designee fee.

LEGAL SEPARATION OR DIVORCE OF MARRIED MEMBERS

In the event a Member becomes legally separated or divorced, the membership shall be maintained unless otherwise agreed and set forth in a written separation agreement or final divorce decree. The legally separated spouse or former spouse, as the case may be, who does not continue with the membership shall no longer have any use privileges at Green Valley Country Club.

Written notice must be given to the Club designating the person who is entitled to continue with the privileges of membership immediately after the divorce or legal separation is declared final. Until written notice has been provided to the Club, each spouse shall be jointly and severally responsible for the payment of all dues, fees and other charges associated with such membership. The Club will not be involved in any dispute and reserves the right to suspend all membership privileges in the event of disagreement over which spouse retains the membership privileges.

H. CLUB OPERATIONS

MANAGEMENT AND CONTROL OF THE CLUB FACILITIES AND OPERATION OF THE CLUB

The Club currently intends to manage and operate the Club Facilities. The Club is responsible for the operation of the Club Facilities and has the exclusive authority to accept Members, establish membership fees, dues, fees and other charges, establish rules and regulations and

control the management and affairs of the Club Facilities.

The Rules and Regulations, including the services provided to Club Members and the hours of operation of the Club Facilities or any portion thereof may be changed by the Club without notice.

Members of the Club are not required and are not permitted to become involved in the management and operation of the Club or the Club Facilities and shall not have any voting privileges.

I. ADVISORY COMMITTEE

ADVISORY COMMITTEE COMPOSED OF MEMBERS SHALL ACT AS A LIAISON

The Club may establish an Advisory Committee (an advisory committee of Members) whose purpose includes fostering good relations between the Members of the Club and management of the Club Facilities and providing Member input on programs and activities provided at Green Valley Country Club. The Advisory Committee will be composed of Resident Members, Non-Resident Members and/or designees of Corporate Memberships appointed by the Club from time to time. Members of the Advisory Committee shall serve staggered terms established by the Club.

The Advisory Committee has no duty or power to negotiate or otherwise act on behalf of the Club, its management or the Members of the Club and serves only in an advisory capacity as a liaison between Members of the Club and management of the Club Facilities, except as otherwise set forth herein.

J. OTHER MEMBERSHIPS AND USE PRIVILEGES

USE OF THE GOLF AND CLUBHOUSE FACILITIES BY GUESTS, NON-MEMBER USERS AND OTHER CLUB GUESTS

The Club will allow use of the golf and clubhouse facilities by Club guests upon payment of the required use fees and compliance with the rules established by the Club.

HONORARY MEMBERSHIPS

A limited number of Honorary Memberships may be issued to persons designated by the Club from time to time. These memberships are in addition to all other memberships to be issued at Green Valley Country Club and shall be available on terms and conditions and allow such privileges as shall be established by the Club. The Honorary Memberships and the users of these Honorary Memberships may be changed at any time by the Club and a new user designated to use the membership privileges from time to time.

PROMOTIONAL USE OF THE CLUB FACILITIES, TOURNAMENT PLAY, SPECIAL EVENTS AND GROUP OUTINGS

The Club shall have the right at any time to hold promotional and other special events, including golf tournaments and group outings, and to promote Green Valley Country Club in advertisements and promotional materials by making reference to Green Valley Country Club and the availability of memberships. The Club reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to restrict or otherwise reserve in advance the Club Facilities or any portion thereof including the golf and clubhouse facilities, for maintenance, tournaments, group outings and other special events from time to time.

K. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF MEMBERSHIP PRIVILEGES

The Club Facilities are owned by the EA Operations LLC or its successors and/or assigns. Membership at Green Valley Country Club is non-equity and non-participatory. Club Membership does not imply any right or privilege to participate in or to administer business policies of the operation or maintenance of the Club Facilities and is not an investment in the Club or the Club Facilities and does not create any equity, ownership or proprietary interest or any prescriptive, easement or other property interest of any nature in the Club, the Club Facilities or any other asset of the Club. Membership at Green Valley Country Club allows the Member to use the Club Facilities, but does not grant to the Member a vested or prescriptive right or easement to use the Club Facilities. Members do not have any interest in the income of the Club and do not have the right to receive any of the Club's assets if the Club is dissolved. A Member only obtains a non-exclusive revocable license to use the Club Facilities in accordance with the terms of this Membership Plan, as it may be amended from time to time.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR CLUB MEMBERSHIP AT GREEN VALLEY COUNTRY CLUB

Each Member at Green Valley Country Club and each designee of a Corporate Membership shall be responsible for the conduct of their guests when using the Club Facilities.

The game of golf is an inherently dangerous activity and injuries may result from using the golf facilities and riding in a golf cart, from using the other facilities provided at the Club and from participating in events and other activities held by the Club from time to time either on or off the Club Facilities. Every Club Member is responsible for any property damage and/or personal injury occurring at the Club Facilities that are caused by the Member and their guests and the Club shall not be responsible or liable for any property damage and/or personal injury occurring at the Club Facilities, including but not limited to, those resulting from the actions of others.

Club Members and designees of Corporate Memberships acknowledge that use of the Club Facilities involves certain risks, including, without limitation, the risk of operating a golf cart, being struck by golf balls and golf clubs and other objects utilized or located at a golf club facility, being struck by lightning and other activities incidental to use of the Club Facilities. Club Members and designees of Corporate Memberships hereby assume all such risks for themselves and their guests and hereby further waive and release for themselves, and their guests, any claims or causes of action which he, she or they may have against the E A Operations LLC or Green Valley Country Club or their directors, officers, shareholders, partners, managers, members, employees, affiliates, representatives, agents, heirs, successors and assigns and the immediate family members of each of them, arising out of injuries or property damage which he, she or they may sustain as a result of use of the Club Facilities or at any event or activity held by the Club or at the Club Facilities, such waiver includes but is not limited to any cause of action relating to use of a golf cart provided by the Club and causes of action relating to being struck by a golf ball or golf club, being struck by lightning and such waiver further specifically includes, without limitation, any claim or cause of action arising out of or in connection with any act or omission, whether due to negligence or otherwise of the E A Operations LLC or Green Valley Country Club or their directors, officers, shareholders, partners, managers, members, employees, affiliates, representatives, agents, heirs, successors and assigns and the immediate family members of each of them. Each Club Member and designee of a Corporate Membership agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the E A Operations LLC and Green Valley Country Club and their directors, officers, shareholders, partners, managers, members, employees, affiliates, representatives, agents, heirs, successors and assigns and the immediate family members of each of them, against any and all claims made by any other person who alleges injury resulting from the sole or comparative negligence of the E A Operations LLC or Green Valley Country Club in connection with such risks.

MODIFICATION AND TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP PLAN

The Club reserves the right to reserve memberships for persons determined solely by the Club, to discontinue operation of any or all of the Club Facilities, to change the Club Facilities available for use by Club Members, to terminate this Membership Plan, to terminate all memberships at Green Valley Country Club with or without cause, to terminate any particular membership (selectively, if so desired by the Club) at Green Valley Country Club with or without cause, and to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of the Club Facilities, in whole or in part, to an equity Member-owned club or to any other third party. Any such recall and termination of a membership may be selective without regard to the date of the application or may be done on a last-in, first-out basis.
