

It is the intent of the management of Green Valley Country Club to limit these Rules and Regulations to the minimum required for the enjoyment of the Club Facilities by all members, designees, immediate family members and their guests. The obligations of enforcing these Rules and Regulations for the good of all users is placed primarily in the hands of a trained staff whose principal responsibility is to assure members of all the courtesies, comforts and services to which a member and guest of Green Valley Country Club is entitled. It is further the responsibility of the membership to be familiar with these Rules and Regulations and to abide by them at all times.

GENERAL CLUB RULES

1. The days and hours of operation of all facilities and services provided at Green Valley Country Club will be established by the E A Operations LLC (the "Company"), a South Carolina company, doing business as Green Valley Country Club (the "Club") considering the season of the year and other circumstances. Certain facilities will be closed from time to time for maintenance, repairs and other purposes deemed necessary by the Club.
2. Members, designees, immediate family members and their guests will have use of the golf facilities and all other facilities at their own risk. Members acknowledge and agree that he/she is responsible for the conduct of the undersigned and his/her spouse, immediate family members and their guests when using the facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club and shall be directly and fully responsible and liable to the Club for any property damage and/or personal injury occurring at the facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club. The Club shall not be responsible or liable for any property damage and/or personal injury occurring at the facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club.
3. Members, designees, immediate family members and their guests must abide by all rules established by the Club as they may be amended from time to time. Members and designees are responsible for ensuring that their immediate family members and guests comply with all rules of the Club.
4. All state and local laws concerning the sale of alcoholic beverages will be strictly enforced. Alcoholic beverages will not be served or sold to any person not permitted to purchase the same under the laws of the State of South Carolina, or any applicable federal, state or local ordinance or regulation. Alcoholic beverages will not be sold for consumption off the Club's premises. All alcoholic beverages consumed on the Club Facilities must be purchased at the Club.
5. Members, designees, immediate family members and guests are not allowed in the golf cart and golf club storage areas, golf course maintenance area, kitchen or other service or restricted areas of the Club Facilities.
6. All food and beverage consumed on the Club Facilities must be purchased at the Club and outside catering is not permitted unless approved by management.
7. Members, designees, immediate family members and guests may not abuse any of the Club's employees, verbally or otherwise. All employees of the Club are under the supervision of the management and no member, designee, immediate family member or guest shall reprimand or discipline any employee, request any employee to perform personal tasks while on duty at the Club, send any employee off the Club Facilities for any reason or request the personal use of the Club's furnishings or equipment which are not ordinarily available for use by members. Any employee not rendering courteous and prompt service should be reported to management immediately. All such reports will be given prompt attention.
8. Advertisements in any form and solicitations of any kind are prohibited on the Club Facilities and shall not be posted on any facility or circulated at the Club without the prior written approval of management.
9. Petitions may be originated, solicited, circulated or posted on the Club Facilities only with the prior written approval of management.
10. Smoking is permitted only in designated outside areas.
11. Loud or offensive language is not tolerated at any time.
12. Dogs and other pets are not permitted on the Club facilities, including golf course (except early morning before play and late afternoon after play).
13. Our newsletter serves as official notification of changes in policies and procedures. We encourage members to read it carefully.
14. All complaints, criticisms or suggestions relating to the operations of the Club Facilities are recommended to be in writing, signed and addressed to the management.
15. The roster of the members of Green Valley Country Club is the property of the Club and may be furnished to members in the sole discretion of the Club. The membership roster shall not be used or given to anyone by a member or designee for any reason whatsoever. Unauthorized release of the membership roster by a member or designee is viewed as a very serious breach of Club policy. Violations will be reviewed by the Club and may result in immediate termination of membership privileges or such other disciplinary action determined appropriate by the Club.
16. The Club reserves the right to modify the privileges of membership in the Club, including but not limited to, establishing rules governing access, sign-up privileges and starting times with respect to the golf course and other recreational facilities provided at the Club.
17. The personnel of the Club have full authority to enforce these Rules and Regulations and any infractions will be reported to the Club Manager.
18. The Club reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to amend these Rules and Regulations as it deems appropriate from time to time and will notify the membership of any change.

CLUB CHARGES AND MEMBER PAYMENTS

1. A Club account number will be assigned to the member and/or designee and his/her spouse (if the family level of dues is selected). Upon completing the Membership Application and Membership Agreement, the Member may select charge privileges for the children listed on the family membership.
2. The opportunity to charge to a member's or designee's personal Club account is extended as a privilege of membership at Green Valley Country Club and is subject to continuing review and approval by the Club. The Club reserves the right to eliminate the use of Club accounts and monthly billings for members and designees and to require that all Club Fees incurred at the Club be charged to a member's or designee's personal credit card or debit card.
3. Members and designees are responsible for the payment of all charges made by their immediate family members and guests.
4. It is the responsibility of each user to retain receipts for charges incurred at Green Valley Country Club. Copies of the monthly charges will not be included in the monthly statement. Receipts will only be mailed upon request if a charge is disputed.



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5. All Club Fees charged to the member's or designee's Club account will be billed monthly. The Club requires a valid credit card and email address for monthly billing of dues, usage fees, and delivery of monthly statements, as well as a picture ID. If payment is not received by the last business day of the month the statement is emailed, past due bills will accrue each month plus a \$25 late fee from the date of the statement until paid in full.
 6. If the Club account of any member or designee is delinquent, the Club may take whatever action it deems necessary to effect collection. If the Club commences any legal action to collect any amount owed by a member or designee, or to enforce any other liability of a member or designee to the Club, and if a judgment is obtained by the Club, the member and designee shall also be liable for all costs and expenses of the legal action and reasonable attorneys' fees (including fees required in connection with appellate proceedings).
 7. Membership privileges may be suspended if Club accounts are not paid in full by the twenty-fifth day of the month and are subject to termination if Club accounts are not paid in full within thirty days after suspension of membership privileges. The Club may, in its sole discretion, determine not to seek the termination of membership privileges. Such determination shall not be deemed a waiver of its right to seek the termination of membership privileges at a later date or against any other member or designee of the Club.
 8. All club services (handicaps, club storage, range and locker) are billed on an annual basis and are not prorated.
No refunds will be given for partially used periods.
2. The Club may at any time restrict, suspend or terminate, for cause or causes described in the preceding paragraph, the privilege of any member, designee, immediate family member or guest to use any or all of the facilities provided at Green Valley Country Club. No such member or designee shall on account of any such restriction or suspension be entitled to a refund of any membership initiation fee previously paid or any portion thereof. During the restriction or suspension, monthly dues shall continue to accrue and shall be paid in full prior to reinstatement as a member or designee in good standing.
 3. The member, designee or immediate family member shall be notified of any proposed disciplinary action and shall be given an opportunity to be heard by the Club to show cause why the individual should not be disciplined in accordance with these rules. If the individual desires to be heard, he/she must provide a written request for a hearing to the management or his/her designee within seven days after the date of the Club's notice to the individual of the proposed action. Upon receipt of the written request for a hearing, the Club shall set a time and date for such hearing, which shall in no event be less than five days and no more than ten days after the date of such request. Depending on the severity of the violation in the sole discretion of the Club, membership privileges/use privileges of the offending member, designee or immediate family member may be suspended by the Club pending a final resolution.
 4. Any member or designee at the Club who has had membership privileges terminated for any reason other than the failure to meet eligibility requirements for membership shall not again be eligible for membership or admitted to use the facilities provided at the Club under any circumstances whether as a guest or otherwise.

SUSPENSION AND TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP/USE PRIVILEGES

1. Membership privileges may be suspended or terminated by the Club or other disciplinary action may be taken which is deemed appropriate by the Club, should a member, designee, immediate family member or guest:
 - a. submits false information on the Application for Membership, which if had been truthfully disclosed, would have rendered the applicant ineligible for membership privileges or use privileges;
 - b. permits the unauthorized use of a member's Club account;
 - c. exhibits unsatisfactory behavior, deportment or appearance or acts in any other manner determined to not be in the best interest of Green Valley Country Club or its members;
 - d. fails to pay the membership initiation fee, monthly dues, monthly statement or any other amount owed to the Club in a proper and timely manner;
 - e. fails to abide by these Rules and Regulations established for use of the Club Facilities, as may be amended from time to time;
 - f. is convicted of a felony or other crime involving moral turpitude;
 - g. treats the personnel or employees of the Club in an unreasonable or abusive manner;
 - h. fails to accompany a guest when required by the Club; or engages in conduct that is improper or likely to endanger the welfare, safety, harmony or reputation of Green Valley Country Club or its members.
 - i. possesses firearms or any other weapons on the Club property at any time.

LOSS OR DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY OR INSTANCES OF PERSONAL INJURY

1. Each member as a condition of membership, and each designee, immediate family member and guest as a condition of invitation to use the Club Facilities, assumes sole responsibility for his/her property. The Club is not responsible for any loss or damage to any private property used or stored at the Club Facilities.
2. Any personal property that has been left in or on the Club Facilities and remains unclaimed for sixty days may be disposed of in any manner deemed appropriate by the Club.
3. Member hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and hold Green Valley Country Club (and their respective owners, directors, partners, officers, operators, employees and other agents) harmless from and against any and all liabilities, costs (including reasonable attorney's fees), claims, demands or damages incident to or arising out of or relating to the acts or omissions of Applicant, their family or guest(s), and their respective use or occupancy of the Facilities. In addition, by executing this Agreement, Applicant hereby voluntarily assumes all risks of accident or damage to Applicant's person or property, and the person or property of Applicant's family and guests, arising out of or relating to the use or occupancy of the Facilities including but not limited to errant golf balls, operation of a golf cart, adverse weather conditions including lightning and acts of omission.
4. Should any member, designee, immediate family member or guest file a legal action against the Company, for any claim and fail to obtain judgment therein against them, the member and designee shall be liable to the Company, for all costs and expenses incurred by them in the defense of such legal action, including reasonable attorneys' fees (including fees required in connection with appellate proceedings).

Rules & Regulations

CHILDREN

1. Parents are responsible for and must control their children with due regard to the wishes and comfort of other members and designees.
2. Children under thirteen years of age are permitted on the Club Facilities only if supervised or accompanied by an adult.
3. Children under the lawful drinking age are not permitted in any bar or lounge unless accompanied by an adult.
4. Children under sixteen years of age are not permitted in the men's and women's locker room facilities unless accompanied by an adult.
5. Each operator of a golf cart must be at least sixteen years of age and have a valid automobile driver's license.
6. Children under sixteen years of age are not allowed on the golf course without adult supervision on Saturdays, Sundays, or Holidays until after 1:00 p.m. unless authorized by the Golf Shop.

GOLF CLUBHOUSE ATTIRE

1. The Club will establish the dress requirements depending on the time of day and the particular facility being used.
2. Members, designees and immediate family members shall dress in a fashion befitting the surroundings and atmosphere.
It is the responsibility of members and designees to advise their guests of the dress requirements.
3. Gentlemen and ladies are requested to dress in a fashion compatible with the appropriate occasion. For lunch, appropriate casual sports attire may be worn.

In the clubhouse, on the golf course and at the practice facilities, the following attire is required to adhere to the tradition and respect for the game:

- Shorts must be Bermuda length
- All trousers and shorts must have a hem
- All shirts must have a collar and sleeves (Mocks are acceptable)
- No denim trousers accepted (golf course or practice facility)
- Non metal spike facility
- Exceptions will be made for members who have just used the pool, fitness area and/or tennis facilities

4. The dress standards of the Club may be changed or waived from time to time for special activities and functions.

MAILING ADDRESSES

1. Each member and designee is responsible for filing with the Membership Office his/her mailing address and email (and any changes to these addresses), to which monthly statements and other correspondence from the Club are to be sent. Members and designees shall be deemed to have received mailings from the Club seven days after they have been mailed to the address on file with the Membership Office. In the absence of an address filing with the Membership Office, any Club mailing may, with the same effect as described above, be addressed as the Club Manager believes is most likely to cause its prompt delivery.
2. The Club must be notified in writing of any change of address. Failure to do so shall constitute a waiver of the right to receive Club notices, bulletins and any other communications and result in a violation of these Rules.

CLUB SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES

1. The Club provides a variety of social, cultural and recreational events in which all members and designees are encouraged to participate.
2. The Club desires to encourage the use of the Club Facilities by members and designees and other persons permitted by the Club for private parties, on any day or evening, provided it does not materially interfere with the normal operation of Green Valley Country Club, or with the services regularly available to the members.

LOCKER ROOMS

1. Lockers may be available for rental on an annual basis payable in advance on January 1st of each year at the fee established by the Club. No refunds on locker rentals will be made.
2. The Club is not responsible for any articles placed in the lockers or left in the locker rooms.
3. All clothing must be kept in lockers. Clothing left out will be collected and put in a storage room and if not reclaimed within sixty days will be disposed of by management of the Club Facilities.




GUEST PRIVILEGES

Guest of members and designees, hereinafter referred to as Guest(s) may be extended guest privileges subject to payment of applicable guest fees and charges and compliance with the rules and regulations established by the Club. Guest privileges may be limited, denied, withdrawn or revoked at any time by the Club. Although it is the intention of the Club to accommodate guests without inconvenience to the members, the Club may from time to time: (i) limit the number of guests that accompany a member or designee on any given day or other time period, and (ii) limit the times a particular person can be a guest at the Club Facilities.

1. The Club may limit the number of times a guest may use the golf facilities during any membership year, excluding the participation in Club tournaments and other Club-sponsored events.
2. Sponsoring members and designees must register their guests with the Golf Shop by providing the guest(s) name when making the starting time. Guests should be accompanied by the sponsoring member or designee at all times when using Green Valley Country Club.
3. Guests will be allowed to use the facilities only in accordance with the privileges of the membership of the sponsoring member or designee upon payment of guest fees.
4. Guest privileges may be limited by the Club, from time to time, in the sole discretion of the Club. Notice of such limitation will be given by the Club.
5. Fees and charges for any services may be paid directly by the guest or may be charged to the Club account of the sponsoring member or designee. Sponsoring members and designees shall be responsible for all unpaid fees and charges incurred by their guests.
6. Sponsoring members and designees are responsible for the conduct of their guests while at Green Valley Country Club. If the manner, deportment or appearance of any guest is deemed to be unsatisfactory, the sponsoring member or designee shall, at the request of the Club, cause such day guest to leave the Club Facilities immediately.

GOLF RULES

General Golf Rules

1. The Rules of Golf of the United States Golf Association ("U.S.G.A.") together with the Rules of Etiquette as adopted by the U.S.G.A. shall be the rules of Green Valley Country Club, except when in conflict with local rules. Local rules, to be in effect, will be listed on Green Valley Country Club scorecard, and/or posted on the bulletin board. It shall be the player's responsibility to keep informed and knowledgeable of course rules.
 2. The Club bulletin board will notify members and designees of future tournaments, corporate and other group outings, fundraising events, charitable events and other times when use of the golf course and other facilities will be restricted or possibly prohibited.
 3. All players, especially children and beginning golfers, are expected to learn and observe the fundamentals of golf etiquette.
 4. All play shall start at #1 tee unless otherwise directed by Golf Shop personnel. Under no circumstances is a golfer permitted to start play from his/her residence.
 5. Practice is not allowed on the golf course. The golf practice facilities must be used for all practice.
 6. Slow play is not tolerated. In the interest of all, players should play without delay. No player should play until the players in front are safely out of range.
 7. Foursomes should complete an eighteen-hole round in the pace of play established by the Club. If a foursome or other group of players is unable to maintain adequate speed of play and fails to keep their place on the golf course, they must allow the following group to play through. Golf Shop personnel have the authority to stop a slow playing group, to allow the following group(s) to play through or to require the slow playing group to pick up their balls and move forward to catch up with the group ahead.
 8. Continued slow play by players will be noted and the golf staff may attempt to improve such player's skills to enable them to complete play within the established pace of play. If such efforts do not result in the required completion time, the Club may limit the play of such players to times other than primary playing times.
 9. All players who stop after playing nine holes for any reason must tee off on the next tee before the following players arrive at the tee or they will lose their position on the golf course and must obtain permission from the starter to resume play.
 10. Each golfer must play from his/her golf bag and with his/her own golf clubs.
 11. All tournament play must be approved in advance by the Golf Professional.
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Rules & Regulations

12. Appropriate golf attire is required for all players on the golf course and golf practice facilities. Members and designees are expected to ensure that immediate family members and guests adhere to such rules. To avoid embarrassment, guests should be informed of the dress policy prior to arrival at the Club.

Gentlemen:	Shirts with collars, dress shirts, slacks and golf shorts up to four inches above the knee are considered appropriate attire. Ladies:	Dresses, skirts, slacks and golf shorts up to four inches above the knee and golf shirts are considered appropriate.	Halter tops, tank tops, tee shirts, fishnet tops, cu-offs, sweat pants, jeans, cargo pants, swimming attire, short shorts, tennis skirts or tennis shorts are not permitted.
Shoes:	Spikeless golf shoes are recommended on the golf facilities.	Shoes other than spikeless golf shoes must be approved by the Golf Shop.

This dress code is mandatory for all players. Improperly dressed golfers will be asked to change before playing. If you are in doubt concerning your attire, please check with the Golf Shop before starting play. **WARNING:** Spikeless shoes are made from material that can cause slipping and falling under certain circumstances. To reduce the risk of injury, exercise caution when walking on wood, steep slopes, dead grass and on hard surfaces such as rocks, concrete, tile, marble, ice and hardwood floors. Worn cleats should be replaced promptly.

13. The golf course may not be used for any purpose except golf. Any non-golf activities such as picnicking, biking, kite flying, soccer, football, recreational walking, jogging, and similar activities are not permitted on the cart paths or golf course unless approved by management. Fishing in lakes from the golf course side is not permitted without the prior approval of the Golf Shop.

14. Members, designees, immediate family members and their guests use the golf facilities at their own risk. If adverse weather conditions and/or lightning are in the area, golfers should seek appropriate shelter immediately. Green Valley Country Club does not have a lightning detection system such as a siren, horn or any other means by which to notify players of inclement weather and any risk of lightning in the area. It is the member, designee, immediate family member and any guests sole responsibility to seek shelter if adverse weather is in the area.

15. Management may close the golf course to play at any time, in its sole discretion.

16. No beverage coolers are permitted on the golf course unless supplied by the Club.

17. Foursomes control the speed of play. Twosomes and threesomes should not expect to play through foursomes and should not exert any pressure on the groups ahead. Foursomes shall have the right of way.

18. Twosomes and singles will be grouped with other players, if available, at the sole discretion of the Golf Shop. Singles shall have no priority on the golf course and shall be permitted to play only at the sole discretion of the Golf Shop.

19. Fivesomes or more are not permitted on the golf course without prior approval of Golf Shop personnel.

20. "Course closed" or "hole closed" signs are to be adhered to without exception.

21. The Club will have outings on the golf course from time to time. Notices of these outings will be posted indicating the hours during which the outing will take place and use of the golf facilities by members and designees may be restricted or not permitted.

22. The Club may promote a caddie program from time to time, and may impose rules requiring the use of caddies and/or fore caddies.

23. Golfers are allowed to walk the course at any time.

HOURS OF PLAY

1. The hours of play and Golf Shop hours will be posted in the Golf Shop.

2. The Golf Course Superintendent is authorized to determine when the golf course is suitable for play. The decision of the Golf Course Superintendent shall be final. In the absence of the Golf Course Superintendent, the Golf Professional on duty shall make this decision.

GOLF STARTING TIMES

1. All players must have a starting time reserved through the Golf Shop. The staff will assign the starting time depending on availability.

2. Starting times may be made by phone during Golf Shop hours as may be posted from time to time.

3. Persons reserving a golf starting time must give their name and membership number and the names of the players in their group at the time of reservation.

4. Starting time changes must be approved by the Golf Shop. Please notify the Golf Shop of any cancellations as soon as possible.

5. Players who fail to cancel their starting time twenty-four hours prior to their scheduled starting time may be charged a no-show fee established by the Club.

6. Golf, Junior Golf, and Corporate Members can make starting time reservations 7 days in advance of play; Nonresident Members can make starting time reservations 5 days in advance of play. Sports Members may make their quarterly tee time 3 days in advance for play after noon.

7. The Club reserves the right to make special considerations for tournaments, special events and out-of-town guests.



REGISTRATION

1. All golfers must register in the Golf Shop before beginning play.
2. Failure to check in and register ten minutes prior to a reserved starting time may cause cancellation, set back or a no-show fee to be charged to the member's or designee's Club account.
3. Players late for their starting time lose their right to the starting time and shall begin play only at the sole discretion of the Golf Professional.

PRACTICE RANGE

1. The practice range is open during normal operating hours as posted in the Golf Shop. At times to be posted in the Golf Shop, the practice range will be closed for general maintenance.
2. Range balls are for use on the practice range only and may not be removed from the practice range. Range balls may not be used on the golf course.
3. Balls must be hit from designated areas only. No hitting is permitted from the rough or sides of the practice range.
4. Proper golf attire is required on the practice range.

GOLF CART USAGE

1. Golf carts shall not be used by a member, designee, immediate family member or guest on the Club Facilities without proper assignment and registration in the Golf Shop.
2. Golf carts may only be used on the golf course when the golf course is open for play.
3. The Club may require that golf carts remain on cart paths to facilitate the grow-in of the golf course and based on course and weather conditions. Players will be informed of this policy prior to beginning play. Exceptions to this "cart on path only" policy for handicap golfers must be obtained from the Golf Shop personnel.
4. Each operator of a golf cart must be at least sixteen years of age and have a valid automobile driver's license.
5. Golf carts cannot be used off the golf course.
6. Only two persons and two sets of golf clubs are permitted per golf cart unless approved by the Golf Shop.
7. Obey all golf cart traffic signs.
8. Golf carts are not permitted on any tee, green or any other designated area. Golf carts must be parked in designated areas with all four tires on the paved parking area.
9. When golf carts are allowed off the cart paths, enter the fairway at a point past the designated entry point. Remain in the fairway while playing the hole and exit the fairway and return to the cart path before the designated exit point. Golf carts must remain on cart paths, without exception, on Par 3 holes.

10. Always use cart paths where provided, especially near tees and greens. Except on cart paths, do not drive a golf cart within thirty feet of a green, tee or bunker.
11. When using power or pull carts and arriving at the green, park cart between the green and the next tee on the cart path. This will allow the following players to play to the green as soon as you complete play at the hole and are off the green.
12. Never drive a golf cart through a hazard.
13. Be careful to avoid soft areas on fairways, especially after rains.
14. Operation of a golf cart is at the risk of the operator and any member, designee, immediate family member and guest using a golf cart accepts and assumes all responsibility for liability connected with operation of the golf cart. Cost of repair to a golf cart that is damaged by a member, designee or immediate family member will be charged to the member or designee or, in the case of damage by a guest, the cost of repair will be charged to the sponsoring member or sponsoring designee. Members and designees using a golf cart will be held fully responsible for any and all damages, including property damage and personal injury, that are caused by the operation of the golf cart by the member, designee, immediate family members and guests, and the members and designees shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Company and all developers, consultants, architects and designers and their directors, officers, shareholders, partners, managers, members, employees, affiliates, representatives and agents and the family members of each of them, from and against any and all losses, damages, claims or proceedings arising out of any property damage or personal injury, whether direct or consequential, arising from or related to the use and operation of the golf cart by the member, designee, immediate family members and guests.
15. Violations of the golf cart rules may result in loss of golf cart privileges and/or playing privileges.
16. The use of privately-owned golf carts is not currently permitted.

HANDICAPS

1. Handicaps are computed under the supervision of the Golf Professional in accordance with the current U.S.G.A. Handicap System and via the Carolinas Golf Association.
2. Members and designees with a U.S.G.A. approved handicap may participate in Club tournaments. Handicaps will be required for all Club events. All handicaps submitted may be reviewed by the tournament committee.
3. After each round of golf, players should enter their score in the handicap computer located in the Golf Shop. The Golf Shop will assist players with the posting procedures.
4. Failure to post a score may result in the Golf Shop posting a score equal to the lowest score of the offending individual's last twenty rounds.
5. The Golf Professional will determine if there are violations in turning in scores and has the right to adjust handicaps.

Rules & Regulations

GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

Persons using the golf facilities should do their part to make a round of golf at Green Valley Country Club a pleasant experience for everyone.

1. Do not waste time. Anticipate the club or clubs you may need and go directly to your ball. Always be near your ball to play promptly when it is your turn. If a player is delayed in making a shot, it would be courteous for such player to indicate for another player to play.
2. The time required to hole-out on and around the green is a chief cause of slow play. Study and clear the line of your putt while others are doing the same. Be ready to putt when it is your turn.
3. Players should ensure that greens are not damaged by putting down bags or the flagsticks and that the hole is not damaged by standing close to it or by removing the flagstick or the ball from the hole. The flagstick should be properly replaced in the hole before leaving the green.
4. No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
5. When approaching a green, the golf cart should be parked on the cart path on the best direct line to the next tee. This can save about fifteen minutes per round. Never leave the golf cart in front of the green where you will have to go back to get it, while the following players wait for you to get out of the way.
6. When play of a hole is completed, leave the green promptly and proceed to the next tee without delay. Do the scoring for the completed hole while the others in the group are playing from the next tee.
7. If you are not holding your place on the golf course (see General Golf Rules #7), allow the players behind to play through. Do the same if you stop to search for a lost ball.
8. Repair your ball marks on the greens. If you see unrepaired ball marks repair them also. Remind your playing partners to observe this courtesy.
9. Enter and leave bunkers at the nearest level point to the green. Carefully rake bunkers after use and place the rake outside the bunker.

EXERCISE RULES

1. Regular operating hours for the exercise facilities will be posted by the Club and may be changed from time to time.
2. Prior to the use of the exercise facilities, a member, immediate family member and any guest will be required to sign a waiver of liability agreeing to hold the Company, Green Valley Country Club, and any management firm retained to operate the Club Facilities on a day-to-day basis, and their directors, officers, shareholders, partners, managers, members, employees, affiliates, representatives and agents harmless from any and all injuries sustained from the use of the exercise facilities.
3. All users must sign in upon entering the facility.
4. The Club may limit the number of guests a member may bring to the exercise facility. Guests using the exercise facilities must be accompanied by the sponsoring member. A guest fee may be charged for each guest. Failure to register a guest may result in the imposition of a fine.
5. Members, immediate family members and guests should first consult their physician before using any of the exercise facilities.
6. Casual workout attire is acceptable at the exercise facilities. Tee shirts, gym shorts or warm-up pants are appropriate for men and leotards, tights, tee shirts, gym shorts or warm-up pants are appropriate for women.
7. Smoking and alcoholic beverages are prohibited at the exercise facilities. No food or drink, except water, may be brought into the exercise facility.
8. It is the responsibility of each user to obtain instruction on how to use the equipment prior to using such equipment, and the equipment is only to be used in accordance with such instructions.
9. It is the responsibility of all persons using the exercise facilities to consult with their physician, and such person should be in good physical condition and have no physical, medical or psychological conditions, disabilities, impairments or ailments, chronic or otherwise, which would preclude, impair or prevent them from safely using the exercise facilities, or engaging in active or passive exercise.
10. ALL PERSONS USING THE EXERCISE FACILITIES DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK All users assume full risk of loss and responsibility for any injury or damage to their health resulting from use of the exercise facilities.
11. Children under sixteen years of age are not permitted to use the exercise facilities unless accompanied or supervised by an adult or otherwise approved in advance by the General Manager.
12. Horseplay, profanity, disruptive conduct and indiscreet behavior at the exercise facilities are strictly prohibited.
13. Radios and other personal electronic devices may only be used with earphones.



SWIMMING POOL RULES

1. Green Valley Country Club pool is for the exclusive, recreational use of Members, their family, and their guests.
2. Proper swimming attire is required.
3. Diving is prohibited in pool area.
4. Certain toys, balls and floats may not be permitted
5. Children 12 and under must have adult supervision at the swimming pool.
6. No running, horseplay, or rude/offensive behavior will be permitted.
7. Coolers are prohibited in the pool area.
8. Pools hours may vary based on the time of year and day of the week and will be posted.
9. All patrons must check in before using the pool.
10. Lifeguards will have 10 minute breaks every hour. At this time all swimmers 18 and under are required to exit the pool. Adults may utilize the pool during this time.
11. In the event severe weather occurs, all members and guests shall be asked to exit the swimming pool immediately.
12. Members must accompany their guests and register their guest(s) with the Club.
13. No glass allowed in pool area.

TENNIS RULES

1. The hours of the tennis operation will be established considering the season of year.
2. All members and guests must register upon entering the tennis facility.
3. All tennis guests must be accompanied by a member.
4. Each member will be required to sign in with their membership number before utilizing the tennis facility.
5. No glass bottles or containers allowed on tennis premises.
6. The courts are available on a first come/first serve basis.
7. Court times are limited to two hours should other players be waiting for the court.
8. Proper tennis attire and etiquette is required while on the courts.
9. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult member when playing at the Club unless otherwise approved by management.
